Introduction

About this book

This book contains 22 activities ideal for use in morning tubs with children in Kindergarten (Prep/Foundation).

To prepare the contents of this packet for use, laminate each printed page for durability and re-use and then cut along the dotted lines. The cards in this packet have been designed to be stored as sets on key rings and for that reason, each card has a hole-punching mark.

I have included photos in this packet showing how the activities in this packet can be used. You may print and store them with the matching activity as a visual instruction card.

Alphabet Lacing Cards

Materials needed: shoestring (or string, yarn, etc.)

Children will thread the shoestring, or other chosen lacing material) through the holes.

Build the feelings playdough mats.

Materials needed: assorted coloured play dough

Children will create the different emotions on the face mat.

Upper Case Letter Building Cards

Children will use the strips to build the letter on the card.

Do the pictures start with the same sound?

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will say the name and identify the beginning sound for the two objects on the card. They will then clip a peg on either the tick or cross to show their answer.

Do the pictures rhyme?

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will say the name of the two objects on the card and determine whether they rhyme. They will then clip a peg on either the tick or cross to show their answer.

Trace the Sight Word

Materials needed: erasable markers

Children will trace the sight word on the card with an erasable marker.

Sorting Letters, Numbers, Words

Children will sort the sandwich cards to the correct lunch box.

Visual Discrimination Cards: Which pose matches the picture?

Materials needed: household peas

Children will identify the stick figure that shows the correct pose of the child by clipping a peg to it.

Left or Right?

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify the facing direction of the object on their card and clip a peg on the correct arrow.

Play Dough Colours: Dress the boy/girl

Materials needed: coloured play dough

Children will pick a card and use the same coloured play dough to make the piece of clothing on the boy/girl.

Copy the Pattern

Materials needed: coloured buttons

Children will recreate the pattern on the card using the coloured buttons.

Number Building Cards

Children will use the strips to build the number on the card.

Trace the Number

Materials needed: erasable markers

Children will trace the number on the card with an erasable marker.

Do they match? Ten Frames

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify whether the two number representation match by clipping a peg on either the tick or cross to show their answer.

Do they match? Counting Fingers

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify whether the two number representation match by clipping a peg on either the tick or cross to show their answer.

Do they match? Number Words

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify whether the two number representation match by clipping a peg on either the tick or cross to show their answer.

How many does the chef need of each?

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will clip a peg on the correct number of each food box to show how many the chef needs of each.

Materials needed: household pegs


