Introduction

About this book

This book contains 22 activities ideal for use in morning tubs with children in Kindergarten (Prep/Foundation).

To prepare the contents of this packet for use, laminate each printed page for durability and re-use and then cut along the dotted lines. The cards in this packet have been designed to be stored as sets on key rings and for that reason, each card has a hole-punching mark.

I have included photos in this packet showing how the activities in this packet can be used. You may print and store them with the matching activity as a visual instruction card.

Upper Case Letter Tracing

Materials needed: erasable markers, write and wipe pocket (optional)

Children will flip through the cards and find the matching letter on the write and wipe card. They will then trace the letter.

Lower Case Letter Tracing

Materials needed: erasable markers, write and wipe pocket (optional)

Children will flip through the cards and find the matching letter on the write and wipe card. They will then trace the letter.

Missing Upper Case Letters

Children will identify the missing letter and place it in the empty box.

Missing Lower Case Letters

Children will identify the missing letter and place it in the empty box.

What is the Beginning Sound?

Children will identify the common beginning sound and place the correct letter in the empty box.

CVC Word Puzzles

Children will put the puzzle strips together to make CVC words.

Rhyming Words

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify which two words rhyme with the first by clipping a peg on their answers.

Sight Words: Scrambled letters

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify which set of two contain the letters needed to spell the focus sight word.

Prepositions: hamster and fox

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify the position of the animals and clip a peg on the correct position.

Visual Discrimination Cards: Which set matches the picture?

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will the set of colored circles that match the tower.

Visual Discrimination Cards: Which set matches the picture?

Materials needed: erasable board, erasable markers

Children will draw the pattern with the missing element on the erasable board.

Select the Correct Set of Directions

Materials needed: household peas

Children will select the set of directions that shows the correct path for the car to get to the flag.

Coat and Button Colours

Materials needed: differently colored buttons

Children will sort the buttons to the matching coloured coat.

Button Patterns

Materials needed: colored buttons

Children will recreate the pattern on the card using the colored buttons.

Picture Symmetry

Materials needed: colored counting cubes or other small objects

Children will complete the other half of the picture by mirroring the first half.

Number Tracing

Materials needed: erasable markers, write and wipe pocket (optional)

Children will flip through the cards and find the matching number on the write and wipe card. They will then trace the number.

Missing Numbers

Children will identify the missing number and place it in the empty box.

What is the Number?

Children will identify the common number and place the correct number in the empty box.

Counting Gumballs

Materials needed: play dough or pom poms

Children will put in the gumball machine the different amounts shown on their card.

Gumball Addition

Materials needed: play dough or pom poms, household pegs

Children will put in the gumball the amount shown on their card. They will add the gumballs and clip a peg on the correct number.

Which set was used to make the picture? (shapes)

Materials needed: household pegs

Children will identify the set of shapes that was used to make the tower by clipping a peg on their answer.

Which is longer/shorter?


Materials needed: household pegs
