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# Introduction 

## About this book

This book contains a collection of worksheets, suitable for use with children in Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten, Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten (Prep).

## Directions for use

Following is an outline of the worksheets included in this unit and suggestions for use.

## 1. Winter cutting practice ( 2 pages)

Children cut out the snowflake shapes on the first page. A mobile can be made with the shapes by making a hole in the top of each snowflake and tying them to a stick with a piece of string. On the second page, children cut along the solid blacklines.

## 2. Winter picture tracing (2 pages)

Children trace the dashed lines on the page to complete the picture and then colorit.

## 3. Winter maze (4 pages)

Children make their way through the maze, starting at the arrow.

## 4. Mitten alphabet tracing (2 pages)

Children trace the letters on the page, and color the pictures.

## 5. Mitten upper and lower case cut and paste letter match (5 pages)

Children cut out the lower case letters from the bottom of the page and paste them in the square beside the matching upper case letter.

## 6. Snowman missing letters cut and paste (3 pages)

Children cut out the letters from the bottom of the page and paste them in the appropriate squares to complete the alphabet sequence.

## 7. Winter beginning sounds cut and paste ( 5 pages)

Children cut out the pictures from the bottom of the page and paste them on top of the corresponding letter.

## 8. Winter syllables (1 page)

Children read the word for each picture and color the corresponding number to show how many syllables.

## 9. Winter snow globe CVC words (1 page)

Children read the 2 words on each snow globe and circle the one that matches the picture.

## 10. Winter rhymes (1 page)

Children read the word on the snowman's board and color the rhyming picture.

## 11. Winter pre-primer sight word match (10 pages)

Children read the word on the large snowball and then color the snowballs that contain matching sight words.

## 12. Winter coloring (1 page)

Children color the objects on the page as directed, then color the rest of the picture as they wish.

## 13. Winter words one-to-one correspondence (1 page)

Children count how many words in each sentence and write the answer in each box.

## 14. Winter read and match cut and paste (1 page)

Children cut out the pictures from the bottom of the page, read each sentence and then paste the corresponding picture in the empty box.

## 15. Emergent reader "Winter Fun" (color and B\&W) \& comprehension sheet

Assembly is required by cutting each page in half, then stapling together on the left side where indicated. I have also included a colored version that teachers can use and keep in the classroom library. There are 2 comprehension sheets: one with pictures to indicate which page children can find the answer, and another without pictures.

## 16. Winter build a sentence (1 page)

Children cut out the words from the bottom of the page and arrange them in order to make a 4 -word sentence.

## 17. Winter positional words in, on, over, in front (1 page)

Children color the object that shows the position at the front of each row.
18. Number words and dots matching cut and paste (2 pages)

Children cut out the dots from the side of the page and paste them next to the matching number word.

## 19. Winter differences (1 page)

Children look at each row of pictures and circle the one that is different.

## 20. Winter what doesn't belong (1 page)

Children look at each row of pictures and circle the one that doesn't belong.

## 21. Building a snowman picture sequencing (1 page)

Children write the numbers 1-4 in each box to show the sequence for building a snowman.

## 22. Winter size sorting cut and paste (1 page)

Children cut and paste the pictures in correct size order.

## 23. Winter shapes cut and paste (1 page)

Children cut out the penguin and snowman head shapes from the bottom of the page and paste them next to the matching shapes.

## 24. Winter numbers cut and paste (2 pages)

Children cut out the numbers from the side of the page and paste them next to the picture that shows the corresponding number.

## 25. Winter less and more (1 page)

Children circle/color the group of objects that is more.

## 26. Winter number sequence ( 2 pages)

Children cut out the numbers from the side of the page and paste them in the correct boxes to complete each number sequence.

## 27. Write the missing numbers (1page)

Children write the missing numbers in the empty boxes.

## 28. Winter cut and paste number order (2 pages)

Children cut out the mixed up pictures from the bottom of the page and arrange them in order ( 1 to 5 and 6 to 10) to reveal the hidden picture.

## 29. Winter count and graph to 5 (1 page)

Children count and graph the pictures.
30. Winter patterns cut and paste ( $\mathrm{AB}, \mathrm{ABB}, \mathrm{ABC}$ ) (3 pages)

Children determine the type of pattern, then cut the pictures from the bottom of the page and paste them in the correct box to finish each pattern.

## 31. Winter addition (2 pages)

Children use the pictures on the page to write and solve an addition sentence.

## 32. Weather sorting (1 page)

Children cut out the pictures from the bottom of the page and paste them in the correct category to show whether the objects are used in the cold or hot weather.
