## introduction

## About this book

This book contains a collection of St. Patrick's Day-themed worksheets intended for use with children in Kindergarten (Prep). They can be used with the whole class or in centers and small groups. They can also be given to children as homework or early finisher work.

## Directions for use

Following is an outline of the worksheets included in this unit and suggestions for use.

## 1. Shamrock syllables

Children color a shamrock to show how many syllables in each word.

## 2. Missing beginning sounds (2 pages)

Children write the missing beginning consonants to complete the CVC words.

## 3. Missing middle short-vowel sounds (2 pages)

Children write the missing middle short-vowels to complete the CVC words.

## 4. Missing ending sounds (2 pages)

Children write the missing ending consonants to complete the CVC words.

## 5. Real and nonsense CVC words

Children follow the real words through the maze.

## 6. CVC crosswords

Children use the picture clues to complete each of the 4 -word CVC crossword puzzles.

## 7. Shamrock beginning L blends

Children color a shamrock to show the beginning blend for the pictures.

## 8. Rhyming clues cut and paste

Children read the clues in each box to help them find the matching picture.

## 9. Shamrock beginning digraphs (ch, sh, th, wh)

Children color a shamrock to show the beginning digraph for the pictures.

## 9. Shamrock long vowel sounds (5 pages)

Children color the pictures that contain the long vowel sound indicated at the top of each page.

## 10. Rainbow CVC or CVCe words (2 pages)

Children say the name of the pictures and color the correct cloud to show whether it is a CVC or CVCe word.

## 11 Color by leprechaun by sight words

Children used the code on to color the leprechaun.

## 12. Write the missing sight word

Children use the picture clues in the first box to work out what the sentence is about. They then complete each of the sentences on the page by selecting and writing the correct sight word on the lines.

## 13. St. Patrick's fluency sight word sentences ( 2 pages)

Children read the sentences on the page and color a shamrock each time they have ready all the sentences.

## 14. "Leprechauns" reading comprehension

Children read a short story and answer the comprehension questions by coloring the correct circle.

## 15. St. Patrick's Day alphabetical order

These pages can be cut in half, or left as they are. Children cut the four words on the right and paste in alphabetical order over the numbers.

## 16. Label the leprechaun

Children cut the labels from the bottom of the page and paste them in the correct spot to label the leprechaun.

## 17. Opposites (hot, big, glad, day)

Children color the picture that shows the opposite of the word in the first box.

## 18. St. Patrick's Day build-a-word booklet (9 words)

Print the pages you wish to use, cut them in half and staple together. Leave letter tiles on the right intact. Children write the words of the images displayed on each page in their booklets and then build the words using the letter tiles provided. I have also included writing lines if you wish for your students to create sentences with the words. The lines can be photocopied onto the back of each page.

* Ink stamps or letters cut out from magazines can be used instead of the letter tiles included in this unit.*


## 19. Rainbow tally marks

Children color the correct cloud to show how many tallies.

## 20. Write the missing numbers

Children complete each of the grids by writing the missing numbers.

## 21. Skip counting missing numbers cut and paste ( $2 \mathrm{~s}, 5, \mathrm{~s} 10 \mathrm{~s}$ )

Children cut the numbers from the bottom and paste in the correct spot to complete the number order.

## 22. St. Patrick's Day place value (2 pages) <br> Children identify how many tens and ones.

## 23. Shamrock domino addition (2 pages)

Children write the number of shamrocks on the domino halves and then add them.

## 24. Leprechaun number bonds (2 pages)

Children write the missing numbers to complete the number bonds.

## 25. Shamrock patterns

Children color the shamrocks to show the pattern type indicated.

## 26. Shapes (square, hexagon, circle, rectangle, triangle)

Children color the shape indicated at the top of the page and then write how many times they found it.

## 27. Telling time (2 pages)

For the first worksheet, children cut and paste the numbers in correct order on the clock. For the second one, children draw the short hand on each of the clock to show the time to the hour indicated.

## 28. St. Patrick's Day count and graph

Children count each of the objects that are the same and complete the graph to show their findings.

## 29. Odd and even number maze

Children follow the even numbers through the maze.

## 30. Closest and farthest

Children color the pictures to show the object closest and farthest.
