

# Introduction

#### About this book

This book contains a collection of worksheets and activities, suitable for use with children in Kindergarten (Prep).

#### Directions for use

Following is an outline of the worksheets included in this unit and suggestions for use.

#### 1. Easter syllables

Children will say the name of each picture and show how many syllables each word contains by coloring the correct circle.

#### 2. Easter eggs and basket lower to upper case letter match (4 pages)

Children will color the lower case letter egg that matches the upper case letter on the basket.

#### 3. Easter egg alphabet order (2 pages)

Children will trace the letters on the eggs and then write the missing letters.

#### 4. Easter beginning sounds

Children will circle the two pictures in each row that start with the same beginning sound, then write that letter on the writing line.

#### 5. Easter beginning blends (3 pages)

Children will circle the two pictures in each row that start with the same beginning blend, then write that letter blend on the writing line.

#### 6. Easter beginning digraphs

Children will circle the two pictures in each row that start with the same beginning blend, then write that letter blend on the writing line.

#### 7. Easter missing vowels

Children will write the missing short vowel sound for each CVC word.

#### 8. Secret CVC words

Children will write the beginning sound for each picture to make a CVC word. They will then cut out the pictures from the bottom of the page and paste them next to the matching CVC words.

#### 9. Easter CVCe words

Children will read the CVCe word and then write it in the shape. Next, they will determine which of three pictures matches the CVCe word by circling it.

#### 10. Easter long vowel sounds

Children will circle the pictures in each row that contain the long vowel sound shown at the start of the row.

#### 11. Easter short and long vowel sounds

Children will select the correct spelling for each picture.

#### 12. Easter word families

Children will circle the two pictures in each row that end with the same word family, then write those two letters on the writing line.

#### 13. Easter egg rhyming words

Children will cut and paste the pictures from the bottom of the page under the matching rhyming word.

#### 14. Easter rhyming words with clues

Children will read the clues, then cut and paste the pictures next to the matching clues.

#### 15. Easter egg sight words (4 pages)

Children will unscramble the sight words and then write them correctly on the line underneath.

#### 16. Easter missing sight words

Children will read the sentences on the page and fill in the blank spaces with the correct sight word.

#### 17. Easter sequencing

Children will read the sentences on the page. They will then cut and paste the pictures next to the matching sentences.

#### 18. Easter ending punctuation

Children will read the sentences on the page. They will then cut and paste the punctuation marks next to the matching sentences.

#### 19. Easter fix the sentence

Children will read the sentences on the page. They will then identify the errors in each sentence and write the sentence correctly on the writing line.

#### 20. Easter picture and word match

Children will cut and paste the words under the matching pictures.

#### 21. Easter label the bunny

Children will cut and paste the label in the correct boxes to label the bunny.

# 22. Decorating Easter Eggs emergent reader - (color and B&W) with comprehension questions

Assembly is required by cutting each page in half and then stapling together on the left side where indicated. Children will have lots of fun coloring and reading this booklet! I have also included a colored version that teachers can use and keep in the classroom library. There are 2 comprehension sheets: one with pictures to indicate the page on which children can find the answer and another without pictures.

#### 23. Easter build-a-word booklet (19 words)

Print the pages you wish to use, cut them in half and staple together. Leave letter tiles on the right intact. Children write the words of the images displayed on each page in their booklets and then build the words using the letter tiles provided. I have also included writing lines if you wish for your students to create sentences with the words. The lines can be photocopied onto the back of each page. \* Ink stamps or letters cut out from magazines can be used instead of the letter tiles included in this unit.\*

#### 24. Easter colors

Children will read the sentences and color the pictures to match.

#### 25. Easter eggs numbers before and after 1-20

Children will write the numbers that come before and after.

#### 26. Easter egg number order 1-20

Children will trace the numbers on the eggs and then write the missing numbers.

#### 27. Easter number order 1-50

Children will trace the numbers and then write the ones that are missing.

#### 28. Easter number order 1-100

Children will trace the numbers and then write the ones that are missing.

#### 29. Easter tulips counting 1-10

Children will count the tulips and color the circle that shows how many.

#### 30. Easter jellybeans counting 10-20

Children will count the jellybeans and color the circle that shows how many.

#### 31. Easter egg graphing

Children will count the items and how many on the graph.

#### 32. Easter bunny peeps ten frame match 1-10

Children will cut and paste the numbers next to the matching ten frame.

#### 33. Easter chicks twenty frame match 11-20

Children will cut and paste the numbers next to the matching twenty frame.

#### 34. Easter egg greater number

Children will identify which number of two is greater.

#### 35. Easter egg comparing numbers

Children will compare two numbers and write the correct sign on the blank egg.

#### 36. Easter bunny whiskers skip counting by 10

Children will cut the numbers from the bottom of the page and paste them in order.

#### 37. Easter eggs skip counting by 5

Children will cut the numbers from the bottom of the page and paste them in order.

#### 38. Easter bunny feet skip counting by 2

Children will cut the numbers from the bottom of the page and paste them in order.

#### 39. Easter ordinal numbers

Children will cut the ordinal numbers from the bottom of the page and paste them in order. They will then color the Easter eggs following the instructions.

#### 40. Easter base ten

Children will count and write how many tens and ones.

#### 41. Easter jellybeans number sense 1-10 (5 pages)

Children will cut the jellybeans from the right side of the page and paste them in the jar with the matching number.

#### 42. Easter chicks making 10

Children will count the chicks and write how many more are needed to make 10.

#### 43. Easter bunny addition within 10

Children will cut out the pictures from the bottom of the page and use them to work out the addition problems.

#### 44. Easter jellybeans addition to 20

Children will count how many jellybeans in each jar and then add.

#### 45. Easter chick subtraction within 10 A

Children will cut out the pictures from the bottom of the page and use them to work out the subtraction problems.

#### 46. Easter bunny carrots subtraction within 10 B

Children will count how many carrots and crosses and then subtract.

#### 47. Easter eggs and basket number bonds 1-10

Children will write the missing number for each number bond.

#### 48. Easter egg patterns: AB, AB, ABC (3 pages)

Children will cut and paste the eggs to complete each pattern.

#### 49. Easter measuring height

Children will color the cubes to show the height of each object.


#### 50. Easter bunny 2D shapes (2 pages)

Children will draw the hour hand and minute hand for each clock.


