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## INTRODUCTION

Explore the exciting world of farm life with our "On the Farm" Preschool Center Activities! This comprehensive resource is designed for Preschool and Kindergarten students. It features a collection of printable, farm-themed activities that make learning fun and engaging.

**Directions for Use:** Below is a detailed outline of each activity, including preparation and instructions on how to use them effectively.

#### 1. Fine Motor Practice Mat (Sheep)

- **Preparation:** Print and laminate the sheep-themed mat for durability. Provide small objects such as pom-poms, beads, or beans for children to place into the circles on the mat.
- **How to Use:** Children place a small object into each circle on the sheep mat, enhancing their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.

#### 2. Farm Write and Wipe Pre-Writing Cards (9 Cards)

- **Preparation:** Print and laminate the pre-writing cards. Cut them apart and punch a hole in the top left corner of each card. Secure them together with a keyring or pipe cleaner.
- **How to Use:** Children use a dry-erase marker to trace the lines from left to right on each card, practicing their pre-writing skills. The laminated surface allows for repeated use.

#### 3. Farm Hen and Eggs Letters and Beginning Sounds Match (13 Pages)

- Preparation: Print and laminate the pages. Cut out all the pieces.
- **How to Use:** Children match lowercase letters and beginning sound pictures to the corresponding hen, reinforcing letter recognition and phonics skills.

#### 4. Farm Syllables (4 Pages)

- **Preparation:** Print and laminate the syllable cards. Cut them apart and provide small pet-themed objects like bottle caps or paw-print buttons.
- **How to Use:** Children identify the number of syllables in each picture and cover the corresponding number on the card using the provided objects, practicing syllable counting.

#### 5. Farm Chicken Coop CVC Word Match (5 Pages)

- **Preparation:** Print and laminate the CVC word match cards. Cut each coop in half to separate the word from the picture.
- **How to Use:** Children match pictures with corresponding CVC words to complete the chicken coop, reinforcing word recognition and spelling skills.

#### 6. Rhyming Sheep (7 Pages)

- Preparation: Print, laminate and cut out the sheep cards.
- **How to Use:** Children match pictures that rhyme, developing phonemic awareness and rhyming skills through this interactive activity.

#### 7. Farm Carrots Pre-Primer Sight Word Building (40 Sight Words)

- Preparation: Print, laminate and cut out the buckets and carrots.
- **How to Use:** Children use the carrot letter tiles to build pre-primer sight words on each bucket card, enhancing their sight word recognition.

#### 8. Farm Mother Duck and Ducklings Number Match (1-10)

- Preparation: Print, laminate and cut out the mother ducks and ducklings.
- **How to Use:** Children match the number representations on the ducklings to the corresponding mother duck, practicing number recognition and counting.

#### 9. Farm Peas in a Pod Counting (1-10)

- **Preparation:** Print, laminate and cut out the counting cards and peas. Optionally, glue peas to clothespins or use pom-poms for counting.
- **How to Use:** Children count the correct number of peas for each pod and place them on the pod cards, reinforcing counting skills and number recognition.

#### 10. Barn and Turkey Shape Matching (9 Pages)

- **Preparation:** Print, laminate and cut the turkeys and barns with shapes.
- **How to Use:** Children match turkeys to the correct barn based on shapes, helping to practice shape recognition and matching skills.

#### 11. Farm Chick and Egg Color Matching

- **Preparation:** Print, laminate and cut out all the pieces.
- **How to Use:** Children match each chick to the corresponding colored egg shell, reinforcing color recognition.

#### 12. Which Picture is Different? Farm Cards (4 Cards)

- Preparation: Print and laminate the picture cards. Cut them apart.
- **How to Use:** Children use a peg to identify and clip the picture that is different from the others, practicing visual discrimination skills.

#### 13. What Doesn't Belong? Farm Cards (4 Cards)

- **Preparation:** Print and Iaminate the "What Doesn't Belong?" cards. Cut them apart.
- **How to Use:** Children use a peg to identify and clip the picture that doesn't belong, enhancing categorization and critical thinking skills.

#### 14. Farm Shadow Matching

- **Preparation:** Print, laminate and cut out all the pieces.
- **How to Use:** Children match each farm-themed card to its corresponding shadow, improving visual matching skills.

#### 15. Farm Sequencing Cards: Life Cycle of a Chicken and Tomato Plant (2 Sets)

- **Preparation:** Print and laminate the sequencing cards. Cut them apart into sets for the life cycles of a chicken and a tomato plant.
- **How to Use:** Children order the cards to show the life cycle sequence of a chicken and a tomato plant, promoting understanding of sequencing and life cycles.

#### 16. Farm Size Sorting (Small, Medium, Large)

- **Preparation:** Print, laminate and cut out all the pieces.
- **How to Use:** Children sort farm animals by size into the correct barn, practicing size comparison and sorting skills.

#### 17. Farm Patterns (AB)

- **Preparation:** Print, laminate and cut out the pattern cards. Attach pictures to the end of clothes pegs using a hot glue gun, if desired.
- **How to Use:** Children identify patterns on the cards and clip the correct picture to complete the pattern, reinforcing pattern recognition skills.
