Perfect for teachers and parents, this plan introduces the traditions of Groundhog Day, explores the habits of groundhogs, and incorporates exciting activities like weather predictions, shadow experiments, and seasonal sorting games. Day 2: Introduction to Groundhog Day

Children will learn about the meaning and traditions of Groundhog Day.

Introduction

Did you know that February 2nd is Groundhog Day? On this day, everyone watches to see if the groundhog will come out of its burrow. If the groundhog sees its shadow, it means six more weeks of winter. If it doesn't see its shadow, spring will come soon! Isn't that fun? Let's learn more about this special day!

Song

"Groundhog Song" (Tune: "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star")

Prop: Groundhog glued to popsicle stick

Actions:

Verse 1: Hold the popsicle stick groundhog in one hand and cover it with the other hand to make a "burrow."

Verse 2: Slowly lift the groundhog up from the "burrow" hand so the head peeks out. Move it side to side like it's looking for its shadow.

Read Aloud & Discussion

Book: "Groundhog's Day Off" by Robb Pearlman

Before Reading: "Look at this silly groundhog on the cover! He looks like he's ready to take a break from something. What do you think he might be tired of doing? As we read, let's think about what makes Groundhog Day such a big job for the groundhog."

After Reading: "Why did the groundhog want to take a day off? What makes his job on Groundhog Day so special? Would you want to be the groundhog on this day, or would you want to take a day off too?"


Activity

Groundhog Day Shadow Craft

Materials: Groundhog printable, crayons or markers, scissors, tape, black construction paper, white or yellow chalk

Activity: Color the groundhog and cut it out. Tape the groundhog face down onto a piece of black construction paper. Using a white or yellow piece of chalk, color in the background around the groundhog on the black paper.

Extension: Discuss how shadows are created by the sun. Place the craft in a sunny spot or shine a flashlight on it to explore how light creates shadows.




Groundhog Song
