

### Penguins on the Move


Eggs, eggs, penguin eggs, Daddy keeps them warm. Safe and snug, with a hug, Through the icy storm!

### Day 2: Where Do Penguins Live?

Children will explore the habitats of penguins and understand how they survive in cold climates.

#### Introduction

Use a globe or map to show where Antarctica is located. "Today, we're going to talk about where penguins live. Penguins live in a very cold place called Antarctica. Let's look at this map and find it! Antarctica is covered in ice and snow. Penguins have special feathers and a thick layer of fat called blubber to keep them warm. And when it's really cold, they huddle together with their friends to stay cozy. How do you stay warm when it's cold?"


### Song

"Penguins on the Move" (Tune: "Row, Row, Row Your Boat") Verse 2

Prop: Snowflake

**Action:** 1. Hug yourself and shiver to show how cold it is.

2. Wave hands around to mimic falling snow.




#### **Read Aloud & Discussion**

Book: "If You Were A Penguin" by Wendell and Florence Minor

**Before Reading:** "The title of this book is If You Were a Penguin. What do you think it would be like to be a penguin? Where do you think penguins live? What kind of place do they need to survive?"

**After Reading**: "What kinds of places did the book show where penguins live? How do penguins stay warm in cold weather? What did you notice about their bodies? If you were a penguin, where would you want to live and why?"



#### **Activity**

#### **Penguin Habitat Craft**

**Materials:** Printable penguin template to be colored, cut, and assembled by children, colored tissue paper squares (shades of blue, white, and gray), white cardstock, glue, scissors.

**Instructions:** Children will create a penguin habitat background by gluing blue, white, and gray tissue paper squares onto a piece of cardstock to represent ice, snow, and water. Next, they will color, cut, and assemble a penguin using the printable template provided, then glue it onto their completed habitat.

**Extension:** Allow children to use different materials like cotton balls for snow, foil for ice, or glitter for frosty effects. Discuss how these materials represent real features of the habitat.





















### Penguins on the Move

Eggs, eggs, penguin eggs, Daddy keeps them warm. Safe and snug, with a hug, Through the icy storm!





















### **Emperor Penguin**

Emperor penguins are the largest penguins in the world! They live in Antarctica and can grow up to 4 feet tall. Their thick feathers and a layer of blubber keep them warm in the freezing cold. Father penguins are amazing caregivers—they keep their eggs safe and warm on their feet until the chicks hatch.



### **Adélie Penguin**

Adélie penguins are small but mighty! These playful penguins live along the coasts of Antarctica, where they build nests out of stones. Adélies are fast swimmers and use their strong beaks to catch krill and fish. Their black-and-white feathers help them blend into their icy surroundings, keeping them safe from predators like seals.








### **Penguin Shadows**

Cut out the pictures and paste them on top of their matching shadows.









### Help the Penguin Find Food

Use different colors to trace the way from the penguin to the different food that it eats.





















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
