

Introduction

Introduce young learners to the important people who help our communities run smoothly! This Community Helpers Preschool Circle Time Plan is a five-day interactive program designed to engage children with fun, hands-on activities, discussions, and read-alouds. Each day focuses on a different helper—mail carriers, police officers, doctors and nurses, bus drivers, and more—encouraging children to explore their roles through storytelling, crafts, and group games. Create & Stamp a Letter Children write or draw a letter, place it in an envelope, and add a pretend stamp. Materials: Letter and stamp printables, envelopes, crayons, markers, glue.
Day 3	Police Officers Children will understand the role of police officers in keepingthe the community safe.	Book: "Keeping You Safe" by Ann Owen Discussion: Ways police of ficers keep the community safe and help people in need.	Police Badge Craft Children cut and decorate their own police badge and wear it while role-playing. Materials: Printable badge templates, scissors, markers, clips or safety pins.
Day 4	Doctors and Nurses Children will understand how doctors and nurses help keep people healthy.	Book: "Keeping You Healthy" by Ann Owen Discussion: How doctors and nurses help us stay healthy and take care of us when we're sick.	Sick Teddy Color Match Activity Children match colored bandages to Teddy's wounds. Materials: Sick Teddy printable, transparent Velcrodots.
Day 5	Bus Driver Children will understand the role of a bus driver and how they help people travel safely.	Book: "Taking You Places" by Ann Owen Discussion: How bus drivers take people where they need to go and keep them safe.	Bus Cut and Glue Craft Children cut out and assemble a bus using glue and construction paper. Materials: Bus templates scissors, glue, crayons, construction paper.

Day 1: Introduction to Community Helpers

Children will understand the concept of community helpers and recognize their roles.

Introduction

Ask the children, "What is a community helper?" Let them share their thoughts. Guide them toward ideas like people who help in different ways—like firefighters, doctors, teachers, and police officers. Discuss how these helpers keep the community safe, healthy, and happy. Ask the children, "Can you think of any other helpers in our community?"

Song

"Community Helpers" verse 1 (Tune: "The Wheels on the Bus")

Prop: None

Action: March in place and pretend to wave to different community helpers.




Read Aloud & Discussion

Book: "Whose Tools Are These?" by Sharon Katz Cooper

Before Reading: "Have you ever seen someone use tools to help get a job done? This book is about different community helpers and the tools they use. Let's see if we can guess which tools belong to which helpers!"

After Reading: "What did we learn about community helpers today? They use special tools to do their jobs. Can you remember which tools belong to which helpers? What tools would you like to use?"




Activity

Who Am I? Community Helpers Guessing Game

Materials: Who Am I? printable cards (12 pages).

Activity: Gather children in a circle. Select a clue card and read the first clue aloud. Allow children to guess the community helper. If no one guesses correctly, read the second clue, then the third if needed. After revealing the correct answer, show a picture of the helper and briefly discuss their role.

Extension: Let children take turns being the clue reader. They can give hints in their own words while classmates guess. This encourages listening, thinking, and speaking skills.




Firefighter

Color the items a firefighter might use.




