Guess the Pet Sound Children listen to pet sounds, guess the animal, and discuss how pets communicate. Materials: Audio clips of pet sounds, speaker /tablet, pet images.
Day 2	Dogs and Cats  Children will compare and contrast the behaviors of dogs and cats using visual cues and discussion.	Book: "If You Give a Cat a Cupcake" by Laura Numeroff  Discussion: How cats and dogs have different needs and how we can take care of them properly.	Compare Dog vs. Cat Behavior Children compare how dogs and cats behave using pictures and discussion. Materials: Dog and cat behavior printables.
Day 3	Small and Unusual Pets Children will demonstrate an understanding of different pet movements by imitating how various animals move.	Book: "Not Norman: A Goldfish Story" by Kelly Bennett  Discussion: What fish need to be happy and how even small pets can be great companions.	Move Like a Pet Children imitate pet movements and play a freeze dance game.  Materials: Open space for movement, pet picture cards.
Day 4	Pet Care & Responsibility  Children will role-play as veterinarians and pet owners to learn about pet care and responsibility.	Book: "How Do Dinosaurs Love Their Dogs?" by Jane Yolen  Discussion: The right and wrong ways to take care of a pet and why pets need love and responsibility.	Pet Care Role Play – Vet Clinic Children pretend to be veterinarians, caring for stuffed animal pets. Materials: Toy doctor kits, stuffed animals, bandages, toy syringes, pretend pet food bowls.
Day 5	My Dream Pet  Children will use creativity to design and describe their dream pet while considering its needs and characteristics.	Book: "What Pet Should I Get?" by Dr. Seuss  Discussion: How to choose the right pet and what to think about before getting one.	Draw My Dream Pet Children draw and describe their dream pet, then share with the class.  Materials: "My Dream Pet" template, crayons, markers.

#### Day 2: Dogs and Cats

Children will compare and contrast the behaviors of dogs and cats using visual cues and discussion.

#### Introduction

Ask the children, "What do dogs and cats eat?" Let them share their ideas and discuss the differences in diet for dogs and cats. Continue by asking, "How do we take care of dogs and cats?" Discuss feeding, grooming, and exercise needs for both pets. Ask, "How do dogs and cats show love?" Explore how pets show affection, like wagging their tails or purring. Help the children notice the differences between how dogs and cats show love and affection.

#### Song

Old MacDonald Had Some Pets" (Tune: "Old MacDonald Had a Farm") one verse or more

**Prop:** Pet props (one or more)

**Action:** Encourage children to sing along and act out the animal movements while making the sounds. Have kids pretend to wag their tails like a dog, swish their whiskers like a cat, or flap their arms like a bird.

#### **Read Aloud & Discussion**

Book: "If You Give a Cat a Cupcake" by Laura Numeroff

**Before Reading:** "Have you ever eaten a cupcake? They are sweet treats for people, but do you think a cat would eat one? This book is about a cat who gets a cupcake, and it leads to a big adventure! Let's find out what happens next!"

**After Reading:** "That cat had such a silly adventure! What happened after the cat got a cupcake? Did he really need a cupcake, or did he need something else? What kinds of foods are good for cats to eat?"


#### Activity

**Comparing Cats and Dogs** 

Materials: Comparing Cats & Dogs printable

**Activity:** Show a card one at a time. Read the description aloud and ask, "Is this something a dog does or something a cat does?" Have a child place the card under "dogs" or "cats" on the sorting board. Once all cards are sorted, go through them as a group and discuss if they are correct. Talk about similarities (both purr or wag when happy!) and differences (dogs love to fetch, cats love to climb!).

**Extension:** Have children take turns picking a card and acting out the behavior while the rest of the group guesses if they are being a dog or a cat.




