From leprechaun tricks to rainbows, shamrocks, and Irish traditions, each day is filled with opportunities for learning through play while building early literacy, math, and fine motor skills. Whether you're a teacher, homeschooler, or caregiver, this resource will bring the luck of the Irish into your classroom with engaging, easy-to-prep activities your preschoolers will love!

### 1. Detailed Circle Time plans

Day 2	The Color Green & Shamrocks  Children will identify and explore the color green and learn about shamrocks.	Book: "Green" by Laura Vaccaro Seeger  Discussion: Things that are green. Why we like the color green. How green is found everywhere.	Green Textured Shamrock Craft Children will create a unique shamrock by decorating it with various green textured materials. Materials: Shamrock template, variety of green textured materials.
Day 3	Leprechauns & Magic  Children will use their imagination to learn about leprechauns and storytelling.	Book: "How to Catch a Leprechaun" by Adam Wallace  Discussion: The children's attempts to catch the leprechaun. Why it's hard to catch a leprechaun. What we'd do if we caught one.	Leprechaun Trap Craft Children will create a leprechaun trap by decorating a bowl and using craft materials to build a trigger mechanism. Materials: Rainbow template, small paper bowl, cotton balls, gold coins, craft sticks, yarn, crayons, paint.
Day 4	Rainbows & Gold  Children will explore colors and patterns by learning about rainbows.	Book: "A Rainbow of My Own" by Don Freeman  Discussion: The boy's rainbow adventure. Imagining a rainbow inside. What we'd do with our own rainbow.	Rainbow Paper Chain Pot of Gold Craft Children will make a rainbow paper chain and a pot of gold with decorative coins. Materials: Template, construction paper, glue, scissors, glitter (optional).
Day 5	Irish Culture & Traditions  Children will learn about Irish culture, including Irish folklore, traditions, and values of kindness and sharing.	Book: "Jamie O'Rourke and the Big Potato" by Tomie dePaola  Discussion: Jamie's giant potato .The lesson of sharing. How we can share with others.	Potato People Craft Children will create their own potato person using a variety of craft supplies.  Materials: Children will create their own potato person using a variety of craft supplies.

### Day 4: Rainbows & Gold

Children will explore colors and patterns by learning about rainbows.

### Introduction

Ask the children, "Have you ever seen a rainbow? What colors do you remember?" Guide them to list the colors of the rainbow. Explain that some people believe there is a pot of gold at the end of a rainbow, and that's why leprechauns love them!

### Song

"I'm a Little Leprechaun" (Tune: "I'm a Little Teapot")

Prop: leprechaun

#### **Actions:**

- Line 1: Crouch down small and wiggle fingers like you're sneaky.
- Line 2: Shake head and wag finger "no."
- Line 3: Pretend to hide something behind your back, then run in place.
- Line 4: Shrug shoulders and wave "bye-bye."




**Book:** "A Rainbow of My Own" by Don Freeman

**Before Reading:** "Rainbows have many colors, and they appear after rain when the sun comes out. What do you think it would be like to have your own rainbow? Let's read and see what happens in this story!"

**After Reading:** "The little boy in the story wanted a rainbow all to himself. What did he do to try to find one? (He imagined it in his room.) Do you think that would be fun? What would you do with a rainbow of your own?"





### **Activity**

### Rainbow Paper Chain Pot of Gold Craft

**Materials:** Templates, construction paper (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, black, and yellow), tape or glue, scissors, glitter (optional).

**Activity:** Give each child strips of construction paper in rainbow and colors and show them how to loop and glue them together to form a chain. Provide each child with a pre-cut pot while they cut out yellow paper circles to create gold coins and glue them onto the pot. Children will use the black paper to create a loop, thread it through the last rainbow loop and glue to the back of the pot.

**Extension:** Add glitter to the coins for extra sparkle, or use markers to label each chain link with the rainbow colors (ROYGBIV) for a learning activity.

### Day 4 Activity: Rainbow Chain Pot of Gold


Print on cardstock and cut out. Use this as a template to trace around onto black cardstock. Cut out or have children cut out the traced pot of gold from the black paper.

Print on yellow paper and have children cut out the gold coins.


Print the template on the next page on ROYGBIV and black colored paper. Cut out and provide children with one of each. They will use the strips to create links.




