



Book: "Butterfly Colors and Counting" by Jerry Pallotta  Discussion: Different types of butterflies, such as Monarchs, Swallowtails, and Painted Ladies, and how their colors and patterns help them survive in nature.	Matching Butterfly Halves Children match butterfly halves on the board, reinforcing symmetry.  Materials: Butterfly matching printable
Day 5	Butterfly Migration Children will understand the concept of butterfly migrate, and how they navigate long distances to find food and warmth.	Book: "Señorita Mariposa" by Ben Gundersheimer  Discussion: Migration of butterflies. Monarchs travel long distances to find food and warmth, and how they navigate during migration.	Butterfly Migration Play Children pretend to be Monarch butterflies, flying from one flower station to another while using straws to "drink nectar." Materials: Cardboard tubes, paint, paintbrushes, straws.

#### Day 3: Life Cycle of a Butterfly

Children will understand the four stages of a butterfly's life cycle and how the caterpillar changes into a butterfly through metamorphosis.

#### Introduction

Ask, "What happens to a caterpillar before it becomes a butterfly?" Explain that today we'll be learning about the life cycle of a butterfly. A butterfly's life starts as an egg, then becomes a caterpillar, next it forms a chrysalis (or cocoon), and finally, it emerges as a butterfly. We will explore each stage in detail and learn how each one is important.

#### Song

"The Hungry Caterpillar" (Tune: "Old MacDonald Had a Farm")

**Props:** caterpillar, chrysalis, butterfly

**Actions:** Verse 1: Use one finger to crawl along your arm. Mimic chewing with your mouth. Verse 2: Use both hands to make a big round shape in front of your stomach. Wrap your arms around your body. Verse 3: Put your hands on your face and "wake up" by stretching and yawning. Flutter your fingers gently up and down like butterfly wings.



#### **Read Aloud & Discussion**

Book: "Caterpillar to Butterfly" by Melissa Stewart

**Before Reading:** "Do you know what happens when a caterpillar becomes a butterfly? How does the caterpillar change?" Explain that this book will show the stages of a butterfly's life cycle.

**After Reading**: "What are the four stages of a butterfly's life cycle? How does the caterpillar change as it grows into a butterfly?" Discuss the four stages: egg, caterpillar, chrysalis, and butterfly. Review how the caterpillar transforms into a butterfly and what happens in each stage.



#### **Activity**

**Butterfly Life Cycle Craft** 

**Materials:** Printable with title, labels for each stage, arrows, branches, and leaves, white paper plate sectioned into quarters, glue, scissors, pasta (rotini, shell, and bow tie, risoni).

**Activity:** Cut out the printable items and glue them onto the presectioned paper plate. Label each section and add the following: for "Eggs," glue a green leaf and risoni; for "Caterpillar," glue a brown branch and rotini pasta; for "Chrysalis," glue a brown branch and shell pasta; for "Butterfly," glue bow tie pasta. Add arrows around the plate to show the life cycle flow.

**Extension:** While crafting, discuss the butterfly life cycle stages, prompting questions like, "How does the caterpillar change into a butterfly?" to promote understanding.



## **Circle Time Props**

Print, laminate and cut out. If using on a felt board, attach velcro to the back of each piece. If using on a white board, attach magnetic strips to the back of each piece.

Print multiple copies and attach to craft sticks for children to use (optional).

#### Actions:

#### Verse 1:

- Use one finger to crawl along your arm.
- Mimic chewing with your mouth.

#### Verse 2:

- Use both hands to make a big round shape in front of your stomach.
- Wrap your arms around your body as if you are wrapping yourself into a chrysalis.

#### Verse 3:

- Put your hands on your face and "wake up" by stretching and yawning.
- Flutter your fingers gently up and down like butterfly wings.










# Monarch Butterfly

The Monarch Butterfly is one of the most recognizable butterflies in the world. It has beautiful orange and black wings with white spots. Monarchs are famous for their long migration from North America to Mexico, where they spend the winter.


- Wingspan: 3.5-4 inches
- Habitat: Fields, meadows, and gardens
- Food: Nectar from flowers



# **Blue Morpho Butterfly**

The Blue Morpho Butterfly is one of the most stunning butterflies in the world! Its iridescent blue wings shimmer in the sunlight, making it a mesmerizing sight in the tropical forests of Central and South America. The bright blue is due to the microscopic scales on its wings, which reflect light in a dazzling way.

- Wingspan: 4-5 inches
- Habitat: Tropical forests of Central and South America
- Food: Nectar from flowers and rotting fruit



# **Leaf Butterfly**

The Leaf Butterfly is a master of disguise. When its wings are closed, they look just like a dead leaf, making it almost impossible to spot in its natural habitat. This clever camouflage protects the butterfly from predators.


