How to Use This Resource

This activity is designed to go with the book Miss Bindergarten Gets Ready for Kindergarten. It's a fun way for students to share something about their morning routine on the first day of school while creating a keepsake class book.

What You Need

- Printable cover page (editable to add teacher name and year)
- One student page for each child
- Crayons, pencils, and markers

Steps

- 1. Read the Book
 - Read Miss Bindergarten Gets Ready for Kindergarten with your class. Talk about how each character got ready for their first day in different ways.
- 2. Discuss Morning Routines
 - Invite students to share one thing they did that morning to get ready for school (e.g., packed their bag, ate breakfast, brushed their teeth).
- 3. Complete the Page
 - Each student completes their page by writing or dictating their name and one thing they did.
 - Students draw a picture in the box to match their sentence.
- 4. Make the Class Book
 - Collect all student pages and place them behind the cover page.
 - Staple or bind the pages to create a class book.
- 5. Share the Book
 - Read the completed book together as a class. Place it in the classroom library so students can enjoy reading about their friends.

Tips for Teachers

- Encourage invented spelling for early writers.
- For students who need support, write their dictated sentence for them to copy.
- Use the book again at the end of the year to compare how students have grown as writers!
