## Introduction

This set of 26 worksheets provides systematic, sound-to-letter practice for every letter of the alphabet. Designed for Kindergarten and early learners, each page helps children connect phonemes (sounds) to graphemes (letters) through engaging, independent activities.

#### What's Included

- One worksheet per letter (A–Z)
- Anchor keyword image for each sound (e.g., apple for A, ball for B)
- Uppercase and lowercase tracing practice
- Mouth formation icon to support articulation and sound awareness
- Picture grid activity: Students color only the pictures that begin with the target sound
- Carefully chosen distractors to strengthen sound discrimination
- Special note for Letter X: The worksheet focuses on the /ks/ sound in final position (as in box, fox, six), reflecting the most common and decodable use of X

#### How to Use

- Introduce each new sound with the anchor image and mouth formation cue
- Have students trace the letters to build fine motor and handwriting skills
- Use the picture grid for independent practice: children identify and color the pictures that begin with the target sound
- Add to literacy centers, morning tubs, independent seatwork, or homework
- Ideal for small group reinforcement or whole-class phonics review










## Sound to Letter: Aa

Trace the letters. Color the pictures that begin with /ă/.















## Sound to Letter: Bb

Trace the letters. Color the pictures that begin with /b/.














## Sound to Letter: Cc

Trace the letters. Color the pictures that begin with /k/.















## Sound to Letter: Dd
