

## Introduction

Invite little learners to explore emotions in a hands-on, developmentally appropriate way. Children choose a face mat, pick an emotion card, and use playdough to build eyebrows, eyes, mouths, and other details that match the feeling. Perfect for preschool and kindergarten morning tubs, calm corners, counseling groups, and SEL centers.

#### **Materials Needed**

- Assorted colored playdough
- (Optional) dry-erase markers, googly eyes, buttons, yarn/pipe cleaners, small mirrors, laminator, binder rings

#### What's Included

- 17 base face mats: 9 girl faces + 8 boy faces in a variety of skin tones and hair colors
- Emotion prompt cards (16 emotions for each skin tone): angry, bored, calm, embarrassed, focused, frustrated, happy, in love, thoughtful, sad, sick, silly, surprised, tired, worried, confident
- Kid-friendly headers and simple icons for quick sorting and independence

#### How to Use

- 1. Children select a face mat and an emotion card.
- 2. Briefly discuss what that feeling looks like (eyebrows, mouth shape, eyes).
- 3. Build the expression with playdough. Encourage language: "I feel \_\_\_ when \_\_\_."
- 4. Share with a partner or small group; others guess the feeling and explain which facial clues helped them.
- 5. Reset the mat and choose a new emotion.

#### Alternative Ways to Use This Teaching Tool

- Dry-erase draw: Laminate mats; students sketch features with markers.
- Velcro/felt pieces: Pre-cut eyes, brows, and mouths to mix and match.
- Calm-down corner: Pair with a mirror and "Try This" cards (breathe, count, stretch).
- Morning check-in: Each child builds today's feeling and shares a sentence.
- Story connections: After a read-aloud, build how a character felt at key moments.
- SLP/ELL support: Use cards to teach emotion vocabulary, synonyms, and sentence frames.
- Counselor/SEL groups: Sort emotions by intensity (mild  $\rightarrow$  strong) or by "comfortable/uncomfortable" feelings.

#### **Educational Benefits**

- Social-Emotional Learning: emotion identification, vocabulary, empathy, perspective-taking, and self-regulation strategies.
- Oral Language & Early Literacy: complete sentences, reasons ("because..."), narrative talk tied to stories.
- Executive Function: attention to visual cues, flexible thinking, and turn-taking.
- Fine Motor & Visual Discrimination: rolling, pinching, placing small pieces; noticing shape and position.

**Prep Tip:** Print on cardstock, laminate, hole-punch the corner, and store mats and emotion cards on binder rings for an easy-to-grab center. Happy Teaching!:)








