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Introduction

Make learning fun and hands-on with these Alphabet Letter Sorting Worksheets A–Z! This engaging set helps children recognize uppercase and lowercase letters while developing fine motor skills through cutting, sorting, and gluing. Each page focuses on one letter of the alphabet with an easy-to-follow sorting task that keeps little learners motivated and confident. Perfect for preschool, pre-k, and kindergarten literacy centers or Letter of the Week lessons.

What's Included

- 26 blackline worksheets, one per letter A–Z
 - Cut-and-paste tiles for uppercase and lowercase on every page
 - Varied, kid-friendly themes (jars, houses, candles, and more)

Prep

1. Print the letter pages you need.
2. Provide scissors and glue.
3. Optional: copy on colored paper for fun or laminate for reuse with transparent velcro dots.

How to Use

1. Students color the page.
2. Cut out the tiles at the bottom.
3. Sort and glue tiles to the matching uppercase or lowercase spot.

Differentiation Ideas

- Highlight the target letter on the page for extra support.
- If using a center with multiple letters, mix in a few “not the letter” tiles for challenge.

Skills Covered

- Letter recognition (upper and lower case)
- Visual discrimination and sorting
- Fine motor skills: coloring, cutting, gluing
- Early phonics routines and print awareness

Classroom Tips

- Use for Letter of the Week, literacy centers, or morning tubs.
- Send home as independent practice.
- Store finished pages in an A–Z binder to create a class alphabet book.

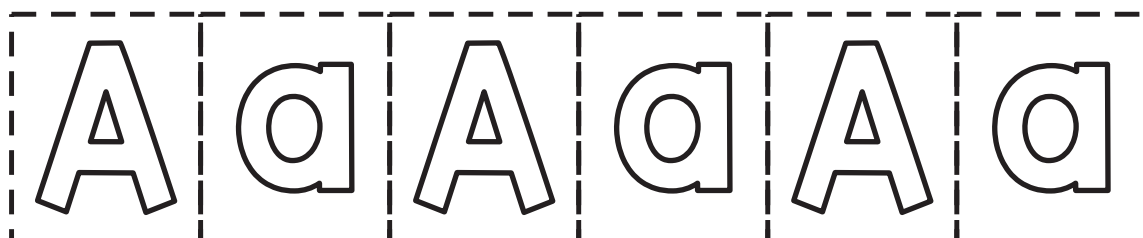
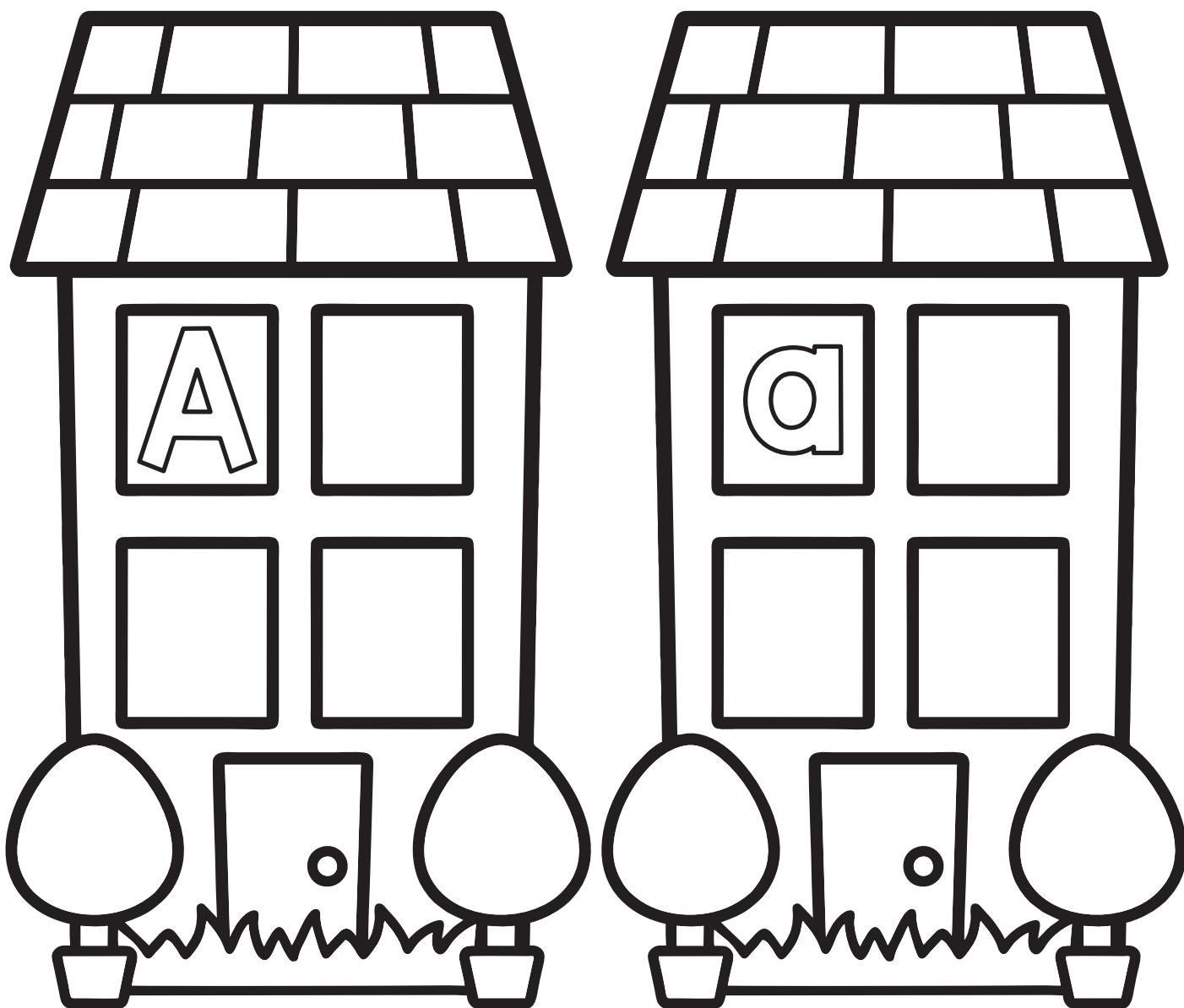

Color the pictures. Cut out the letters from the bottom of the page and glue them on the correct buttons.

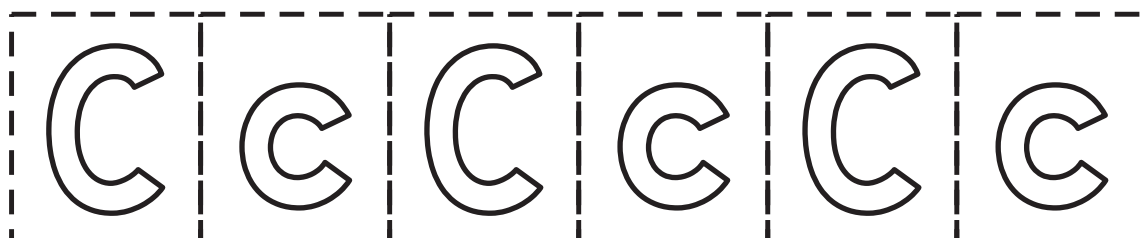
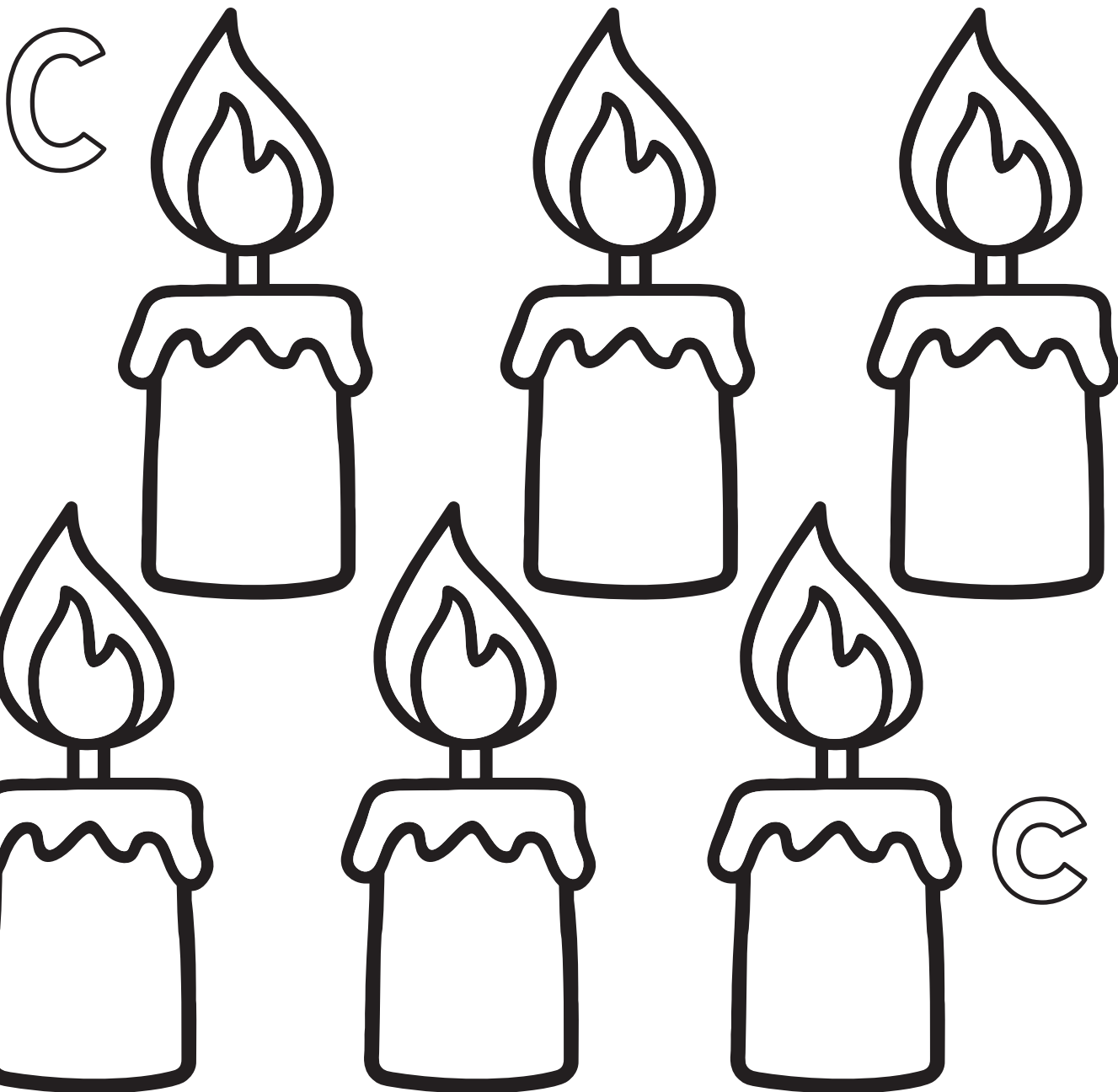
