

Introduction

Build letter recognition and fine motor skills with these no-prep Alphabet Dot Marker pages! Each letter includes an uppercase and lowercase worksheet so students can practice forming letters while strengthening hand-eye coordination.

What's Included

- 52 black-and-white worksheets (A–Z uppercase and lowercase)
- Large bubble letters with dot circles to fill
- Simple keyword picture on each page (e.g., A is for apple / a is for ant)

How to Use

- 1. Print the pages you need (single letters for focus lessons or the complete set for an alphabet unit).
- 2. Provide students with dot markers—or substitute with:
 - Pom-poms with tongs
 - Round stickers
 - Cotton swabs dipped in paint
 - Crayons, markers, or bingo chips
- 3. Model how to start at the top and move left to right as students dot each circle to "build" the letter.
- 4. Invite students to read the simple sentence at the bottom and color the picture as a fast finisher.

Educational Benefits

- Alphabet Knowledge: Reinforces uppercase and lowercase letter shapes and common letter-sound connections.
- Fine Motor & Hand Strength: Repeated dotting strengthens finger muscles and pencil control.
- Visual Tracking: Dots guide left-to-right and top-to-bottom movement.
- Multisensory Learning: Tactile, visual, and kinesthetic practice supports early learners.
- Easy Differentiation: Use uppercase for beginners and lowercase for students ready for the next step.

Teaching Ideas

- Morning tubs, literacy centers, independent practice, early finisher tasks, sub plans
- Send home for extra practice or include in an alphabet notebook
- Laminate or place in write-and-wipe sleeves for repeated use
- Pair with alphabet songs, read-alouds, or letter hunts for a complete lesson


- Print and go—no cutting required

These alphabet dot pages make letter practice simple, hands-on, and stress-free. Perfect for preschool, pre-K, transitional kindergarten, and kindergarten.




