This book contains a collection of Winter-themed literacy worksheets designed to support early reading, phonics, and foundational literacy skills in Kindergarten. The activities are ideal for whole group instruction, literacy centers, independent work, or small group support throughout the winter season.

What's Included

This resource includes a variety of winter themed literacy activities focusing on phonics, CVC words, sight words, sentence work, and early reading comprehension.

How to Use

Below is an overview of each activity type included, along with suggestions for classroom use.

1. Winter Syllables (3 pages)

Children say the name of each picture and identify how many syllables each word has by coloring the correct circle. Dot markers can also be used.

2. Winter Hat and Mittens Upper and Lowercase Match (6 pages)

Children identify the beginning sound of each word and color the circle that shows their answer. Dot markers can be used for added engagement.

3. Winter Beginning Sounds (2 pages)

Children identify the beginning sound of each word and color the circle that shows their answer. Dot markers can be used for added engagement.

4. Winter Beginning Blends

Children listen for the beginning blend in each word and color the correct blend choice.

5. CVC Words – Missing Beginning and Ending Sounds

Children write the missing beginning and ending letters to complete each CVC word shown by the pictures.

6. Mystery Winter CVC Words

Children write the beginning sound for each picture in a row. Once complete, the sounds form a CVC word. Children read the word and match it to the correct picture.

7. Winter Sound Positions (Beginning, Middle, Ending)

Children listen for a target sound and identify whether it appears at the beginning, middle, or end of each word by coloring the correct circle.

8. Hot Chocolate Word Family Cut and Paste (5 pages)

Children cut out word cards and paste them next to the correct word family mug or cup.

9. Write the CVC Words

Children say the name of each picture and write the sounds they hear to spell the full CVC word.

10. Long and Short Vowel Sort – Cut and Paste (5 pages)

Children sort pictures by short and long vowel sounds by cutting and pasting them into the correct columns.

11. Color by Sight Words (4 pages)

Children read the sight words and color each section of the picture using the provided color code.

12. Mystery Sight Words

Children write the beginning sound for each picture. When the row is complete, a sight word is formed. Children read the word and write it on the line.

13. Missing Winter Sight Words

Children use picture clues and a word bank to choose and write the correct sight word to complete each sentence.

14. Write the Missing Word

Children use picture clues to understand each sentence and select the correct word to write on the lines.

15. Winter Reading Comprehension

Children read a short winter themed passage and answer comprehension questions by circling the correct answer.

16. Label the Arctic Animals and Winter Pictures (3 pages)

Children cut out the labels and paste them next to the correct parts of each animal or winter picture.

17. Color the Winter Pictures

Children read each sentence and color the picture to match the description.

18. Winter Build-a-Word Vocabulary Booklet (16 words)

Children trace each word, build it using letter tiles, and color the picture. Pages are assembled into a booklet by cutting and stapling as directed.

Educational Benefits

These activities help children develop:

- Phonemic awareness and phonics skills
- Letter recognition and sound identification
- CVC word building and decoding
- Sight word recognition and usage
- Sentence reading and writing skills
- Early reading comprehension
- Fine motor skills through cutting, coloring, and pasting

Classroom Tips

- Laminate selected pages and use with dry erase markers for literacy centers
- Pair cut and paste activities with small group instruction
- Use dot markers or counters for hands on phonics support
- Send selected pages home for extra practice or homework
- Mix worksheet types to support differentiation












Winter Letter Match 1

Circle the lowercase letter that matches the uppercase letter.










Winter Short A and Long A Sort






Winter Short E and Long E Sort
