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Introduction

This printable packet includes a collection of Spring themed sentence building activities designed to support early reading and sentence structure skills in Kindergarten and early Grade 1. The activities are provided in two differentiated worksheet versions, allowing teachers to easily meet the needs of emerging and developing readers.

What's Included

- Sentence scramble word cards
- Cut and paste sentence building worksheets (two worksheet versions for differentiation)

How to Use

- *Sentence Scramble Center*

Print and laminate the word cards for durability. Cut along the dotted lines to separate the words. Children arrange the cards to build a sentence in the correct order. After building the sentence, they write the sentence on the worksheet to reinforce word order and sentence structure.

- *Worksheet Version 1: No Model Sentence*

This version is designed for children who are ready to build sentences more independently. Students cut and paste the word cards in the correct order and then write the sentence without a visual sentence prompt.

- *Worksheet Version 2: Model Sentence Included*

This version provides a printed sentence at the top of the page to support children who need additional guidance. Students use the model sentence to help order the word cards correctly before writing the sentence.

Educational Benefits

- Builds early sentence structure and word order awareness
- Reinforces sight words and simple vocabulary
- Supports fine motor development through cut and paste activities
- Encourages confidence with early reading and writing
- Allows easy differentiation within the same activity

Classroom Tips

- Use the model sentence version for guided practice or small groups
- Offer the no model sentence version as an extension or challenge
- Mix both versions in literacy centers for natural differentiation
- Encourage children to read their completed sentences aloud

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


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


