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PRINTING TIP This resource has been designed for printing on A4-sized paper. If you are printing on a different size, select "shrink to printable area" or "print to fit page" (or a similar option) in order for the contents of this unit to print correctly.

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Introduction

This hands-on learning folder helps children learn and remember an important phone number. Children build the number using numeral tiles, say it aloud, and then pretend to dial it on the phone keypad.

The activity supports numeral recognition, sequencing, fine motor skills, and personal safety. Mats are included for common American, Canadian, and Australian home and mobile phone number formats, along with open-ended mats for other number formats.

What's Included

- Full-color numeral tiles
- Black-and-white numeral tiles
- Phone number activity mats in several number formats
- Open-ended activity mats without number boxes

Preparation

1. Select the activity mat that matches the phone number format you need.
2. Print and laminate the mat, or place it inside a reusable plastic sleeve.
3. Print and cut apart the numeral tiles.
4. If desired, attach clear hook-and-loop dots to the number boxes and the backs of the tiles.
5. Store the activity in a binder, folder, or learning center.

How to Use

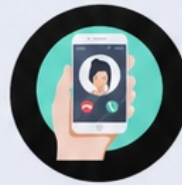
Provide children with the numeral tiles needed to make their phone number. Have them place the tiles in the correct order, say the number aloud, and then pretend to dial it on the keypad.

Begin by providing a written model for children to copy. Gradually remove the model as they become more confident recalling the number independently.

Safety Note

Remind children that phone numbers are private information and should only be shared with trusted adults or used when seeking help. Children should use the illustrated keypad for pretend practice and only use a real phone with adult supervision.
